

## SCHEDULE

1. Replace the definition of Contract Cleaning Sector in clause 2 of the Contract Cleaning Sectoral determination published in Government Notice No. 622 dated 14 May 1999 with the following:

**“Contract Cleaning Sector” means the sector in which employers and employees are associated for the purpose of cleaning or washing by hand or machine, of furniture, windows, carpets, doors, floors, tools, machinery, under supervision at industrial and commercial premises, buildings, and flats that are let commercially or any airplanes, trucks, cars, buses, trains or any other vehicle requiring to be so cleaned.”**

2. Substitute clause 3 as reflect in Government Gazette No. 34798 of 28 November 2011 with the following schedule below:

### 3. Remuneration

- (1) With effect from 1 December 2012 an employer shall pay a contract cleaning worker at least the minimum wage prescribed in the schedule.
- (2) Despite clause 3(1), an employee who works for less than six hours on any day must be paid for at least six hours on that day.
